Scholarship



- Amount of Scholarship: There will be one scholarship awarded in the amount of \$500 to a high school student or adult wishing to further their education.
- Eligibility Requirements:
 - Applicant must be a candidate for high school graduation or a high school graduate or earned a high school diploma or equivalent with a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or higher.
 - Applicant must be attending or plan to attend any two (2) year or higher accredited public or private institution in the State of Wisconsin offering an associate or undergraduate degree or a vocational/technical program.
 - Applicant must reside in a property in Wisconsin which is part of a USDA Rural Development program. WI-CARH is expanding the opportunity to not only current residents, but now to property employees, or a direct family member of a property employee of a WI-CARH member affordable housing community. Resident applicants must submit verification from the WI-CARH member that the applicant is a resident in good standing.
